San Jose's airport is beginning to fill up with private jets arriving for Sunday's Super Bowl like this Gulfstream G450, which – for several thousand dollars an hour – can take you and 15 friends nearly 5,000 statute miles nonstop. That's more than twice the one-way distance from Charlotte to San Jose. The airport will close all or parts of three taxiways to park up to 180 aircraft on game day. More than 1,000 private jets are expected at all Bay Area airports combined.
